- 6 Discuss bid results for Road Improvements 2022. Entertain a motion to recommend awarding the contract for Road Improvements 2022 to the low bidder, Pioppi Construction, in the amount of \$951,499.50 for the base bid only, not including Alternate 1.
- 7 Discuss the amendment to Tighe & Bond's contract for Sludge Conveyance Upgrades to provide additional construction phase services for a fee not to exceed \$9,500, to be funded from Account #600440-583000-23583 (FY23 Tech Support Capital Budget).
