5. Discussion opened with T. MacDonald stating the Phase I environmental surveys were completed by Tighe & Bond. The review of appraisals by Tyburski was also completed. Phase II environmental surveys are partially completed for the main property. The completion is temporarily on hold due to concerns of the property owner. Design is currently on hold until it is likely the properties are secured. MacDonald and Pomroy suggested giving Kaestle Boos the okay to start the schematic design, however the committee was hesitant until the property acquisition was closer to completion. More accurate estimates could be identified. The project managers are still suggesting that demolition and preparation of the site should bid separately. M. Langevin asked if would be cheaper to build a two-story facility. Both McKeon and MacDonald agreed only if there were severe site restrictions or obstacles. The concerns pointed out by a citizen regarding Westville Dam were addressed. The only reason the dam does not carry the highest condition level is that there would be economic impact if a catastrophic failure were realized.
